Despite the cold and higher expenses, Maegan would still recommend others to visit Nashville. “Driving through the mountains was absolutely beautiful.” she said

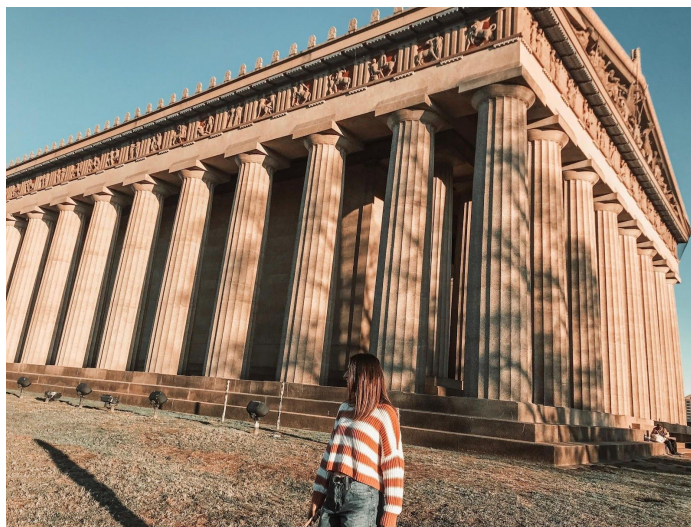
